Three types of learning opportunities: Available to eligible employees in the IT Group



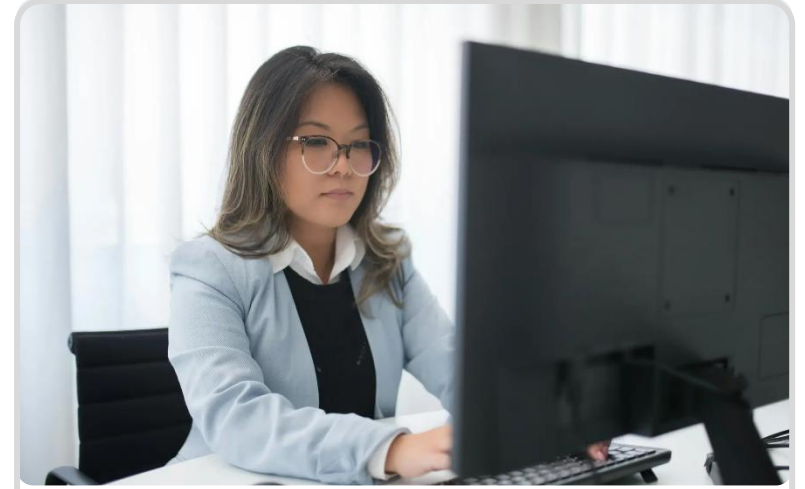
1. Online self-paced learning

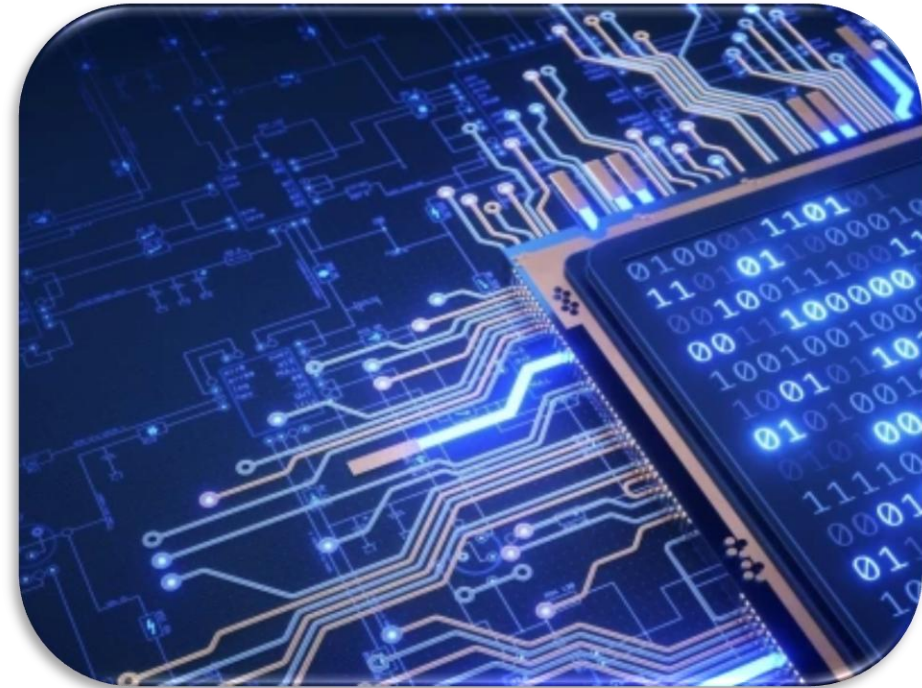
